Homework:

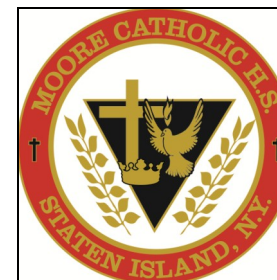
Students will be assigned homework daily in each class.

Registration
