## **Homework:**

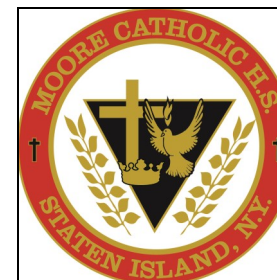
Students will be assigned homework daily in each class.
